Ames Police Investigate Shots Fired

On January 15, 2025, at 7:45 p.m., the Ames Police Department received a report of the sound of gunshots in the 3100 block of Quartz Avenue. Officers located a townhouse that had been shot multiple times. The resident was not home at the time of the shooting. Officers collected evidence from the scene and conducted a neighborhood canvas.

Based on our initial investigation, we do not believe there is an ongoing threat to the public. The Ames Police Department continues to investigate this incident. The Ames Police Department was assisted by the Story County Sheriff's Office.
