#### What to Include with Your Rebate Application

• Analysis of the change and an executive summary must accompany this claim form that:

- outlines the change made,
  - provides kW use prior to the change,
  - provides kW use of the equipment if it met only the minimum efficiency level required by the relevant standard or code requirement, and
- provides new kW use after the change.
- All data is subject to verification.
- Product manual with manufacturer, model number, and specifications.
- An itemized and dated receipt or invoice.

#### Terms and Conditions

- Participants must be pre-approved; call 515-239-5177 or email joel.zook@cityofames.org.
- Custom rebate is only available for projects that do not meet standard rebate criteria
- Project must permanently reduce summer peak-time kilowatts (kW) compared to a standard or code if applicable to qualify. For air conditioning equipment, compare the new equipment efficiency to that required in the currently applicable IECC code. Rebates are intended for equipment that exceeds the IECC code or other applicable standard or benchmark.
- Incentive will be calculated as qualifying kW saved compared to the relevant standard or code.
- All custom rebates will be evaluated by City of Ames Electric Services. Electric Services reserves the right to deny any claim that does not meet the goal of reducing summer peak-time demand.
