## **UPDATE: Ames Police Investigate Shooting**

On February 27, 2025, at 1:15 a.m., a 19-year-old victim reported he was shot in the abdomen in the 2500 block of Jensen Avenue. The victim was transported by private vehicle to Mary Greeley Medical Center and treated for his injuries.

At the hospital, the victim said he was robbed and shot by two males. He said the suspects fled the area in a dark four-door car. He described one suspect as a heavy set, short white male. The second suspect is described as a tall black male.

**UPDATE:** As the result of the continued investigation, Maliek W. Dut, age 22, of Ames was arrested today and charged with Robbery 1<sup>st</sup> Degree, a class "B" felony and Attempted Murder, a class "B" felony.

The Ames Police Department continues to investigate this incident.
